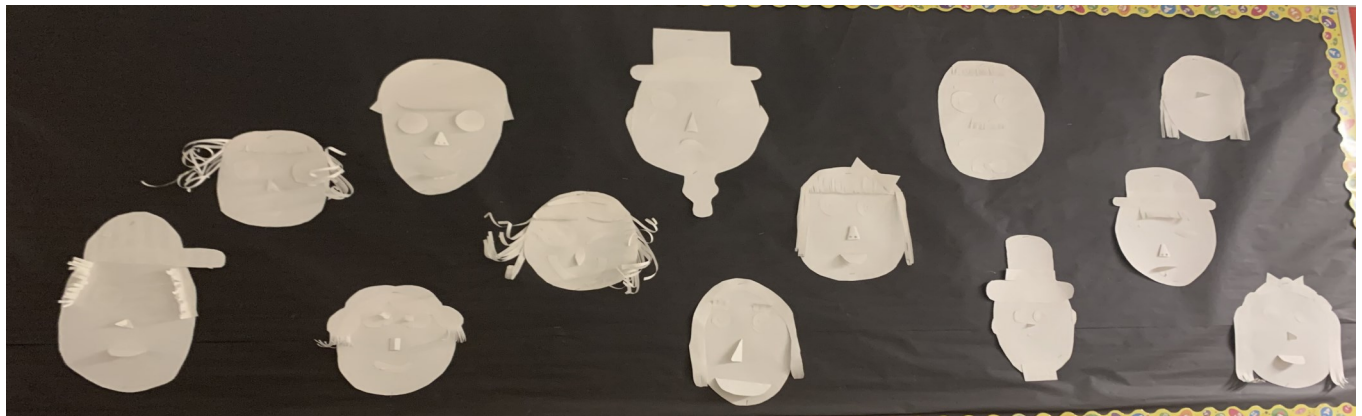

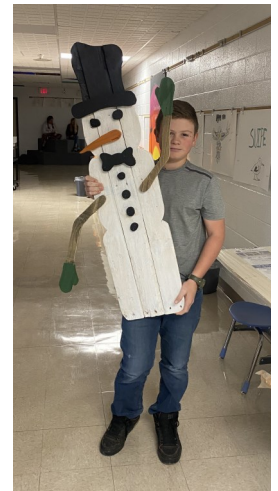

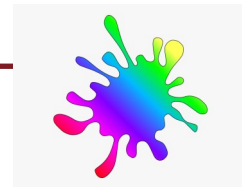


Grade 3/4 Antics
