The school year is quickly coming to an end. We have a little less than three weeks left before the start of Summer Break. With that said there is lots to accomplish before we finish the school year on June 16th. Some of our classes have already enjoyed their year end field trips and others will be enjoying theirs in the days ahead.

Even with a few weeks left in this school year we are already busy planning for next school year. We have made a small adjustment to our timetable for next year. 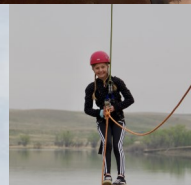
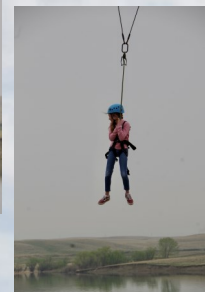

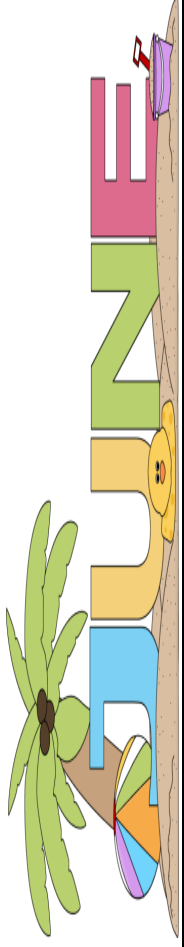
