- 1) **Student Demographics** please review to ensure it is correct, update any items that have changed and return to the school signed and dated on the last page.
- 2) Lord's Prayer (opt out) Students at our school recite the Lord's Prayer each day. If you wish for your child/children NOT to participate, then sign the form and return to the school.
- 3) **Off Site Activities One form for each student.** Please write your student's name on this permission form, sign, date and return to the school.
- Technology Agreement This is for Grades 1-9 students only. It provides each student the opportunity to use Chromebooks or other devices in the school. Parents must sign, date and return a form to the school for each child in your family
- 5) Student Threat Assessment Fair Notice and Process the letter and brochure inform parents that all threats/behaviours will be dealt with. It explains who will be involved and the purpose of this process. This is for your information and does not need to be returned to the school.
- 6) **Magnetic Calendars** one per family, please put up on your fridge.
