- 5) **Student Threat Assessment** – Fair Notice and Process – the letter and brochure inform parents that all threats/behaviours will be dealt with. It explains who will be involved and the purpose of this process. This is for your information and does not need to be returned to the school.
- 6) **Magnetic Calendars** – one per family, please put up on your fridge.
