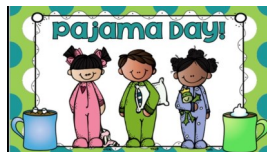


## Enchant School

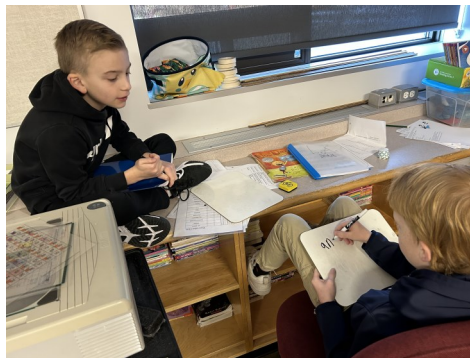


Western Day

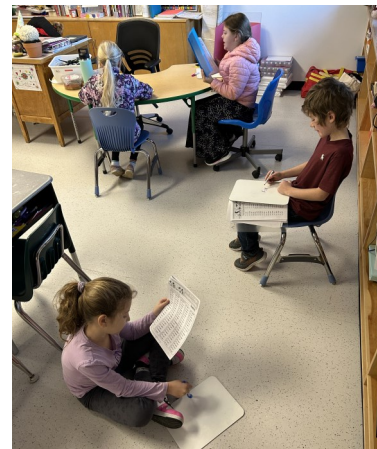
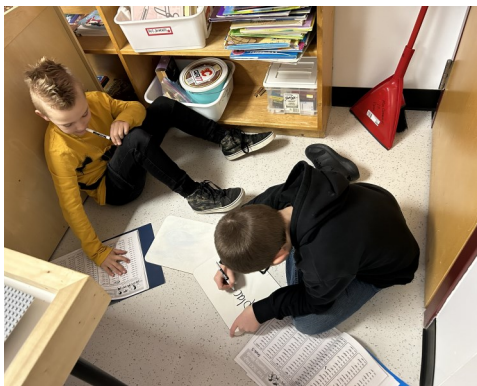




After cutting out hearts for a service project the Jr. High class decided to play in the snow for a little while. They were definitely glad for the warmer weather.



## WordWork



One of the activities Grade 3/4 have been doing this year is word work with a partner or group. Using the list of 300 high-frequency words from the curriculum, the students take turns reading out words for their partner to spell. This has become a favourite way to improve writing/spelling strategies, and also prompts students to discuss homophones (ie. blue vs blew)!

Kindergarten has had a wonderful start to 2024! We have been hard at work again learning letter names and sounds as we are done over half the alphabet. We have been introduced to rhyming words and have been enjoying some rhyming stories/books. In math, we continue to do some number comparisons and try to remember to use the terms less/more/same when making comparisons. We will be starting some simple graphs in the next couple of weeks and we will use our number comparison skills when looking at the graphs we build. Our theme has been centered around winter (and we sure have had the cold weather to go with that! Brrr!). Kindergarten had lots of fun skating and we would like to thank everyone who made that possible from the arena caretakers, "ice" makers, parents coming to help, staff and older students in our school who helped kindergarten. This is such a great opportunity for our students. Thank you!




During this last month as a group, we explored the Arctic and play invitations. We read the mitten book together and each child was able to participate by being an animal. Through some play exploration with tires, children began to notice how different yet similar all the tracks were to one another.
