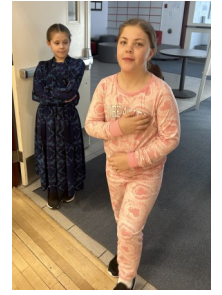

On Thursday, March 28th the school will be swimming at the Y in Lethbridge. We are excited about that upcoming trip. This is something the students are always very excited about.

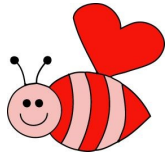
Report Cards will be coming home on March 13th. Watch for those in your child's backpack.
