

Students have participated in a wide range of activities with her, including a novel study using the book Fantastic Mr. Fox and learning about Indigenous groups in Alberta. Most recently, Miss W. led the students through a drama activity where they created tableaux. Can you guess what scene/activity each group was depicting?!











In November the children were very busy. There were many new interests explored such as wood working, collage making, letters, colours, and singing. The children were introduced to the first letter of their name and the sound that it makes. In the classroom we have had letter hunts and been connecting the sounds we hear with words. Messy play came about during offered painting times. The children explored it with many different objects and the properties of it. Messy play allows the children to create and explore different avenues that open up new language and skills.

We are looking forward to our Winter Celebration in December as we count down the holidays together.







November has been a fantastic month in the grade one classroom! We have a student teacher and he has been doing a great job. Mr. M is an amazing musician and he plays the harmonica, guitar and flute. We have all enjoyed hearing his instruments! In math class the grade one's are starting addition and subtraction. We are all working on becoming better readers and writers. Everyone has been reading and writing daily! In science we have been learning about properties of matter. The kids have been exploring maps in social studies. We are looking forward to December and are











November has flown by! In science, grade two students used their five senses to explore the properties of different materials. They used their knowledge of properties in a cracker taste test. Students have been working hard on writing more detailed sentences and various ways to add detail. In math, students have been working on addition with regrouping, odd and even numbers, and comparing and ordering numbers. We have just started learning about fractions. We have been hard at work practicing our Christmas concert song, and can't wait to sing it for everyone.











Kindergarten students are always hard at work in Enchant School. We have just recently been introduced to the concepts of patterning and have masted a two item pattern. We are now working on three item and some combination of objects type patterns. We have started to listen for rhyming words in books and how we can match rhyming words/pictures together by saying the word and listening for the ending sounds.

Thank you to all parents who took the time to come to parent teacher interviews. It is great getting to know you and your child through these types of conferences.

As we look forward to December, kindergarten will be presenting the nativity story as well as singing a song at the school Christmas concert. Students are quite excited to perform so we hope to see you there!
















The Junior High has been busy finishing up the last snowman orders from the Harvest supper. Thank you for your hard work.
