- 4) **Technology Agreement** This is for Grades 1-9 students only. It provides each student the opportunity to use Chromebooks or other devices in the school. Parents must **sign**, date and return a form to the school for each child in your family
- 5) **Student Threat Assessment** Fair Notice and Process the letter and brochure inform parents that all threats/behaviours will be dealt with. It explains who will be involved and the purpose of this process. This is for your information and does not need to be returned to the school.
- 6) Magnetic Calendars one per family, please put up on your fridge.
